National Youth Award winner Sadau Asom Gramya Puthibharal Santha is a state level voluntary organization which came in existence on 27th January, 1985 and is registered under Societies Registration Act. 1860. Since its inception the Sadau Asom Gramya Puthibharal Santha has successfully implemented various schemes related to women and children and among them Family Counselling Centre (FCC) is a prominent scheme.

FAMILY COUNSELLING CENTRE WHAT IT MEAN

Family Counselling Centre is a cell to settle up the family disputes and restore conjugal life by way of mutual understanding. The scheme of FCC was launched by Government of India in 1983. At present approximately 800 FCC are functioning in different state.

FCC under Sadau Asom Gramya Puthibharal Santha is committed to serve all women who are victims of atrocities. From its inception 1802 Nos. cases registered and 1072 Nos. cases has been disposed.

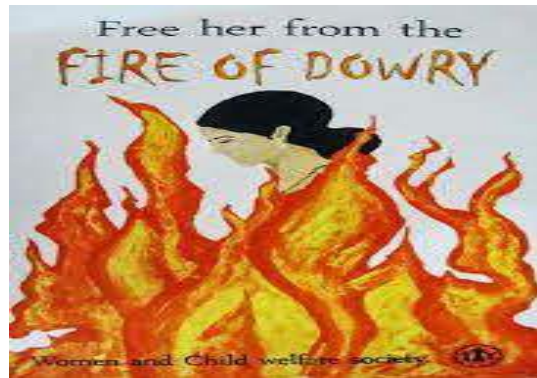
