Open Shelter Home is a Child friendly centre. It is a community based facility for children in need of residence, support, on short term basis with the objective of protecting them from abuse or keeping them away from a life on the street.

The Ministry of Women and Child Development, Govt. of India introduce the scheme in the year 2009 with the help of State Child Protection Society (SCPS) Govt of Assam. The aims of the scheme are to safe custody of the child between 6 to 18 years.

## Category of Child for Open Shelter Home

Different categories of children are come in open shelter home like – Orphan, Single parents, Street child, Child labor , Child marriage , Traffic victim, Communal Conflict, rack pickers, Drug addicted, Missing child etc.

- **Regular School:-** Some children who are staying in home in maximum period those children were admitted to regular school as per RTE act 2009. In the year 2017-18 the 3nos. of children were admitted to regular school.
- **Counseling:-** Counseling also done when required.

**Extra Curriculum Activity:-** The children from Home are participated in different competition and Workshop organized by SCPS & NGO.

**Record Maintain and Report:-** Personal file, Case file, attendance Resister for children and staff , Visitor register , Restoration file, diet, health check up file maintain by home and also uploading the children details to the website. The MPR ,QPR CPMIS and Status report also submitted to SCPS and DCPO Kamrup (M) as well as to the General Secretary of Santha.
